

# What Your Doctor Needs to Know

Dear Healthcare Provider,

Your patient is participating in the Smoking Cessation Program provided by SCT Management Services, L3C (SCTMS). This program is a statewide 10-year smoking cessation program to benefit all Louisiana residents who started smoking cigarettes before September 1, 1988 and desire to quit smoking. These smokers are known as Scott Class Beneficiaries.

This program provides for the reimbursement of Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT), Telephone Quit Line Services, Office Visits and Counseling. ## contracted providers

If you are currently a contracted provider with the Smoking Cessation Program or the Gilsbar 360° Alliance PPO, and your patient receives services covered under the Smoking Cessation Program, you will bill using Payer ID #07205.

## non-contracted providers

If you are **NOT** currently a contracted provider with the Smoking Cessation Program or the Gilsbar 360° Alliance PPO, the smoking cessation service(s) you provide to your patient will not be eligible for reimbursement by SCTMS. As a provider, you can consider joining the Gilsbar 360° Alliance PPO Network by calling 1-866-605-6797 and a Gilsbar representative will be happy to assist with this process.

## eligible CPT codes

Certain CPT codes for services rendered for the purpose of smoking cessation services are eligible under this Program. For a complete list of eligible CPT codes, please see the back of this page. To ensure proper claims processing, please use the applicable CPT codes only.

### Eligible Group Counseling CPT Codes

*Up to 18 visits per Benefit Year*

- 90853 – Group psychotherapy (other than a multiple-family group)
- 96153 – Health & Behavior Intervention, each 15 Minutes, Face to Face; Group (2 or More Patients)
- 96154 – Health & Behavior Intervention, each 15 Minutes, Face to Face; Family (With Patient Present)
- 96155 – Health & Behavior Intervention, each 15 Minutes, Face to Face; Family (Without patient present)
- 99078 – Physician educational services in a group setting

### Eligible Individual Counseling CPT Codes

*Up to 4 visits per Benefit Year*

- 90804 – Individual psychotherapy, insight-oriented, behavior modifying and/or supportive, in an office or outpatient facility, approximately 20 to 30 minutes face-to-face with the patient
- 90805 – Individual psychotherapy, insight-oriented, behavior modifying and/or supportive, in an office or outpatient facility, approximately 20 to 30 minutes face-to-face with the patient, with medical evaluation and management services

- 99152 – Health & Behavior Assessment/Intervention, each 15 Minutes, Face to Face; Individual
- 99401 – Preventive medicine counseling and/or intervention to treat the risk factor of tobacco use provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 15 minutes
- 99402 – Preventive medicine counseling and/or intervention to treat the risk factor of tobacco use provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 30 minutes
- 99403 – Preventive medicine counseling and/or intervention to treat the risk factor of tobacco use provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 45 minutes
- 99404 – Preventive medicine counseling and/or intervention to treat the risk factor of tobacco use provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 60 minutes
- 99411 – Preventive medicine counseling and/or intervention to treat the risk factor of tobacco use provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 30 minutes
- 99412 – Preventive medicine counseling and/or intervention to treat the risk factor of tobacco use provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 60 minutes

### Eligible Provider Based Office Visit CPT Codes

*Up to 4 visits per Benefit Year*

- 96150 – Health & Behavior Assessment, each 15 Minutes, Face to Face with the Patient; (Initial Assessment)
- 96151 – Health & Behavior Assessment, each 15 Minutes, Face to Face with the Patient (Re-Assessment)
- 99385-thru- 99387 & 99395 -thru- 99397: Preventive Medicine Services
- 99406 – Smoking and tobacco-use cessation counseling visit; intermediate, greater than 3 minutes up to 10 minutes. Short descriptor: Smoke/Tobacco counseling 3-10
- 99407 – Smoking and tobacco-use cessation counseling visit; intermediate, greater than 10 minutes. Short descriptor: Smoke/Tobacco counseling greater than 10 minutes
- G0436 – Smoking and tobacco cessation counseling visit for the asymptomatic patient; greater than 3 minutes, up to 10 minutes
- G0437 – Smoking and tobacco cessation counseling visit for the asymptomatic patient; intensive, greater than 10 minutes

When providing an E/M service, if greater than fifty percent of face-to-face time with patient is spent in counseling, time may be used as a basis for selection of level of service.

### Important Member Benefit Coverage Information:

Approved SCT members will be eligible for up to two 120-day benefit coverage periods in their Benefit Year.\* SCT Members will need to notify SCTMS at 1-855-259-6346 or (504) 529-5665 to activate their second 120-day benefit coverage period, should they desire additional covered Smoking Cessation services.

\*Benefit Year – Represents a 365 day period beginning with SCT member's effective date.
